CCPS Placement Cycle Calendar BANRC & LANRC Spring/Summer 2017

August 15 - September 2, 2016

Hospitals review, confirm and extend availability through August 31, 2017 for both cohort and preceptor programs. We understand some hospitals will need to modify future availability if census and building plans change. These changes can be done as needed throughout the year.

September 6 - September 23, 2016 (Preceptor requests due November 11)

Schools make requests for all courses that start January 2017 through the end of the spring/summer terms. (Courses that usually end by August 31)

September 26 - October 14, 2016 (Preceptor placement decisions due December 9)

Hospitals review proposed requests and make placement decisions. Hospitals are encouraged to accept long-standing/historic placements and to decline proposals they know they cannot accommodate as quickly as possible, as a courtesy to schools.
